

Neck Pain & Treatment Options



❖ Should You Seek Medical Treatment?

Immediate medical care should also be sought when an injury causes pain in the neck that radiates down the arms. Radiating pain or numbness in your arms causing weakness in the arms or legs without significant neck pain should also be evaluated.

You should contact your physician to seek medical care when the neck pain is:

- Continuous, persistent, and severe
- Accompanied by pain that radiates down the arms
- Accompanied by headaches, numbness, tingling, or weakness

❖ Common Causes of Neck Pain

• Neck pain may result from abnormalities in the soft tissues - the muscles, ligaments, and nerves - as well as in bones and joints of the spine. In some people, neck problems may be the source of pain in the upper back, shoulders or arms.

• Degenerative and inflammatory diseases are causes of neck pain that includes osteoarthritis and rheumatoid arthritis. Both of these major types of arthritis can cause related stiffness and pain.

• Cervical disc degeneration can also cause neck pain. The disc acts as a shock absorber between the bones in the neck. As the disc space narrows, added stress is applied to the joints of the spine causing further wear and degenerative disease. The cervical disc may also protrude and cause pressure on the spinal cord or nerve roots when the rim of the disc weakens. This is known as a herniated cervical disc.

❖ About the DRX9000C™
